

Topic: Called To Be Part of God's Family

Prayer: Psalm 133

Start your prayer time by reading Psalm 133 aloud. Reflect on the beauty and blessing of unity within the body of Christ as depicted in this Psalm. Consider the imagery of oil and dew —symbols of anointing and refreshment that God bestows upon His people when they live in harmony.

Meditate

Read: Acts 2:42-47 (NIV)

In Acts 2, we witness a powerful display of the Holy Spirit's descent upon the believers gathered in Jerusalem for the Feast of Pentecost. This event marked the birth of the early church, where we see the believers experiencing a profound unity and fellowship that is worth exploring.

During this time, Jerusalem was overflowing with Jewish pilgrims from all parts of the world who had come to celebrate Pentecost. The cultural context is essential here as the diverse backgrounds of these believers reflected the breadth of God's salvation plan for all nations, in fulfillment of Old Testament prophecies.

In Acts 2:42-47, we see how the believers devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching, to fellowship, to the breaking of bread, and to prayer. This deep sense of community and shared purpose was foundational to the early church's growth and impact.

The practical insights we can draw from this passage are manifold. First and foremost, we learn the importance of unity in the body of Christ. Despite their differences, the believers were united in their devotion to God and to one another. This unity allowed them to bear witness to the world effectively.

Furthermore, their commitment to fellowship reminds us of the significance of community in our spiritual journey. We are not meant to walk this path alone but to support, encourage, and

strengthen one another in faith.

The breaking of bread together not only signifies the practice of communion but also represents the sharing of meals and resources among the believers. This act of sharing fostered a spirit of generosity and care within the community.

Lastly, the believers' dedication to prayer highlights the necessity of seeking God's guidance and empowerment in all aspects of our lives. Prayer is a powerful tool that connects us to the source of our strength and wisdom.
